



# 2023 Introduction to Service Rifle Shooting & Beginner Match



**PURPOSE:** This introductory course is designed for individuals interested in learning about Service Rifle competition and Camp Perry.

**DATE:** -Scarborough F&G Clinic on Saturday May 20, 2023  
Beginner Match on Sunday May 21, 2023

**TIME:** Report to High Power clubhouse to sign in on Saturday at 7:30 – 7:45AM. Classroom Begins at 8:00 AM. If not present and signed in by 7:50 am your spot goes to people in line on the waiting list. Participants will proceed to the Range for instruction & firing at approximately 10am after classroom training is complete.

**BEGINNERS MATCH:** Report to High Power clubhouse by 9am.

**LOCATIONS:** Scarborough Fish and Game Association: 21 Fish and Game Ln, Scarborough, ME 04074

**ENTRIES:** Limited to maximum of 20 Entries as to not over crowd clubhouse for morning classroom session Pre-registration opens April 30, 2023. A waiting list will be maintained if the clinic fills to capacity.

**FEES:** Cash or checks accepted.\* Fee includes instruction; membership in Pine Tree State Rifle & Pistol Assn.; Scarborough F&G range fee and use of rifle and .223 ammunition for the clinic. Current PTSR&P members receive \$15 discount (\$2 Junior discount). \$10 discount price for two-day registration.

**EQUIPMENT:** AR-15A2 & A4 Optical Service Rifles and ammunition provided for clinic use by PTSR&P. Students may use their own rifle if pre-approved by team armorer. A \$20 dollar discount will apply if participants choose to shoot their own rifle & safe ammunition.

**CLINIC COURSE OF FIRE:** All clinic firing at 200 yards, 40 Shots for record. Two 3 shot sighting groups prone position and four single fire sighters.

10 record shots: Prone single load

10 record shots: Prone Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 70 seconds

10 record shots: Sitting Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 60 seconds

10 record shots: Standing / Offhand. Single load

**BEGINNERS MATCH COURSE OF FIRE:** 50 Shot National Match Course

2 Sighters & 10 record shots @ 200 yards Standing / Offhand. Single load

2 Sighters & 10 record shots: @ 200 yards Sitting Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 60 seconds

2 Sighters & 10 record shots: @ 300 yards Prone Rapid. Load and 2 Rd Mag then 8 Rd Mag in 70 seconds

2 Sighters & 20 record shots: @ 600 yards Prone single load

58 Rounds total: 600 yard stage requires match grade ammunition and will be provided to participants.

Individuals not on paper within 4 shots at 600 yards may be removed from firing that stage.

**TARGETS:** All firing will be on NRA Approved Targets.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Dress for the weather. No Lunch break, we eat on the go. Bring your own food and water as none is provided or available at the range. A folding camp chair is recommended.

**RANGE OPERATION:** Competitors will be required to score and pull targets.
