RULES	Current NRA High Power Rules apply. The challenge fee is \$3.00 upon initiating a challenge. The fee will be refunded if the challenge is in favor of the challenger by the jury. Empty Chamber Indicator is to be used. Available for \$2.00 at the range. Block time may be used in Slow Fire stages/matches. SF&GA Rifle Range Rules will be followed. Shooters must have zeros for each yard line they plan to shoot. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the "5 Shot Rule" and will be enforced. Ammo: No larger than 35 caliber. Bullet weight must be 75 grain or heavier for shooting at 500 or 600 yard lines.
