RULES

- 2024 NRA High Power Rules will apply including any provisional rules.
- · Block times will be used for all stages.
- Empty Chamber Indicators are required and will be available for \$2.00 at the range.
- The challenge fee is \$3.00 upon initiating a challenge. The fee will be refunded if the challenge is resolved in favor of the challenger by the jury.
- SF&GA Rifle Range Safety Rules will be followed.
- Shooters must have zeros for each yard line they plan to shoot. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the "5 Shot Rule" and will be enforced.
- Ammo: No larger than 35 Caliber.
- Bullet weight must be 68 grain or heavier for shooting at 500/600-yard lines.

COMPLIANCE

The Match Director may check for proper weights, rifle and supporting equipment configuration at any time.

ELECTRONIC TARGETS

Matches will be fired on Electronic Targets. NRA Rule on Electronic Scoring Rule 10.17 will be used. There will be no pit duty, but all competitors will have scoring duty and assistance in mounting and storage of target frames will be required. During competitions only the relay shooting, their scorers and match officials will be allowed on the firing line. Please bring a tablet if you have one, we will have loaner tablets if you do not have one.

2024 NRA High Power Rules shall apply, specifically, Rule 8.3 Team Time Allowance, Rule 10.17 Electronic Scoring Targets, Rule 11.6.8 Squadding of Team, Rule 12: Team Officers Duties and Position, Rule 19.12: Team Classification shall be based on the average of the team member's individual classification.

TEAM AWARDS

Team winners will be based on the 2-day aggregate score of each team. There will be awards for the aggregate winning team and for the top aggregate scoring team for each of the following rifle disciplines: Service Rifle, NRA Match Rifle, AR Tactical (.223/5.56), AR Tactical (Open), FTR and F-Open.
