ENTRIES & FEES	Limited to 52 Competitors. \$80 per Team. Check payable to SF&GA. Each competitor will receive copy of the official results.
RULES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 4 Shooters -Teams May be larger, but only 4 shooters per relay, pair firing will be required for each relay.</li><li>• NRA Fullbore Rules will Apply – <a href="https://competitions.nra.org/media/8910/2023-fullbore-rules.pdf">https://competitions.nra.org/media/8910/2023-fullbore-rules.pdf</a></li><li>• Teams for NRA Score Submittal shall be Target Rifle, F-Open and FTR.</li><li>• AR-Tactical Teams are welcome and will have a separate award structure and no NRA score submittal.</li><li>• Empty Chamber Indicator is to be used. Available for \$2.00 at the range.</li><li>• SF&amp;GA Rifle Range Safety Rules will be followed.</li><li>• Shooters must have zeros for the yard line they plan to shoot. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the “5 Shot Rule” and will be enforced.</li><li>• Ammo: No larger than 35 Caliber.</li><li>• Bullet weight must be 68 grain or heavier for shooting at 500/600-yard lines.</li></ul>
COURSE OF FIRE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 15 Shots for Record for Each Shooter (4) - 2 convertible sighters for each string.</li><li>• 45 seconds per shot per shooter.</li><li>• Total of 15 record shots per shooter per relay including converted sighters</li><li>• 60 shots per string per team and an aggregate of 180 shots per team shooter (max value per team 720)</li></ul>
AWARDS	Award to the team with the high aggregate score.
RIFLES	NRA High Power Rifle Rules: Section 3.1 Service Rifle, Section 3.2 Any Rifle, Section 3.3 NRA Match Rifle Section 3.3.1 US Palma Rifle, Section 22 F-Class Open Rifle (F-O) and F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR) Section 23 NRA Mid-Range (Prone) Tactical Rifle (AR)
NOTES	ELECTRONIC TARGETS: Matches will be fired on Electronic Targets. NRA Rule on Electronic Scoring Rule 10.17 will be used. There will be no pit duty, but all competitors will have scoring duty and limited assistance in mounting and storage of target frames. Only the shooting relay, scorers, match officials or coaches will be allowed on the firing line doing competition. Please bring a tablet if you have one, we will have loaner tablets if you do not have one.
