**EVENT TIME** Squadding starts at 8:00 am and ends at 8:30 am. Firing starts at 9:00am. Entry closes day of match at 9:00am. No entries after 09:00 day of match.

**ENTRIES & FEES** Limited to 52 Competitors. \$35.00, \$20.00 for Juniors. Check payable to SF&GA. Each competitor will receive copy of the official results.

**COMPLIANCE** The Match Director may check for proper weights, rifle and supporting equipment configuration at any time.

**RULES**

2023 NRA High Power Rules apply. The challenge fee is \$3.00 upon initiating a challenge. The fee will be refunded if the challenge is in favor of the challenger by the jury. Empty Chamber Indicator is to be used. Available for \$2.00 at the range. Block time may be used in Slow Fire stages/matches. SF&GA Rifle Range Safety Rules will be followed. Shooters must have zeros for each yard line they plan to shoot. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the "5 Shot Rule" and will be enforced. Ammo: No larger than 35 Caliber. Bullet weight must be 68 grain or heavier for shooting at 500/600-yard lines.

**COURSE OF FIRE** 2 Sighters at each Stage. Match 5 is total of 4 stages.

2	200	20	Sitting	60 sec/10 rds.	SR
3	300	20	Prone	70 sec/10 rds.	SR-3

**CLASSIFICATIONS** NRA Classification system will be used. Classes that do not have 5 competitors will be combined upward. Unclassified shooters will shoot as Unclassified-Master class.

**AWARDS** Maine State Highpower and Open Championship award will go to the competitor from Maine with the high score in Match 5. Individual Match Awards: Awards will be given to the high Score, high Junior, and high Woman. Awards will be given to the high score per NRA Classification. Classes with 4 or less competitors will be combined with the next higher class. Competitors are limited to one award per match.

**RIFLES** NRA High Power Rifle Rules: Section 3.1 Service Rifle, Section 3.3 NRA Match Rifle

**NOTES** Competitors will have pit duty and scoring duties. Only the shooting relay, scorers, and match officials will be allowed on the firing line doing competition
