### RULES

- 2024 NRA High Power Rules will apply including any provisional rules. Block times will be used for all stages.
- Empty Chamber Indicators are required and will be available for \$2.00 at the range.
- The challenge fee is \$3.00 upon initiating a challenge. The fee will be refunded if the challenge is resolved in favor of the challenger by the jury.
- SF&GA Rifle Range Safety Rules will be followed. Shooters must have zeros for each yard line they plan to shoot. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the "5 Shot Rule" and will be enforced.
- Ammo: Safe ammunition to be supplied by competitor. No larger than 35 Caliber.
- Bullet weight must be 68 grain or heavier for shooting at 500/600-yard lines.

COMPLIANCE The Match Director may check for proper weights, rifle and supporting equipment configuration at any time.

### ELECTRONIC TARGETS

Matches will be fired on Electronic Targets. NRA Rule on Electronic Scoring Rule 10.17 will be used. There will be no pit duty, but all competitors will have scoring duty and assistance in mounting and storage of target frames will be requested. During competitions only the relay shooting, their scorers and match officials will be allowed on the firing line. Please bring a tablet if you have one, we will have loaner tablets if you do not have one.

### CLASSIFICATIONS

NRA Classification system will be used. Classes that do not have 5 competitors will be combined upward. Unclassified shooters will shoot as Unclassified-Master class.

Unlimited Sighters for the first and fifth matches. 2 sighters for all other matches. Block time may be used in matches.

### AWARDS

- Maine State Mid-Range Championship award will go to the competitor from Maine with the high score in Match 9.
- Individual Match Awards: Awards will be given to the high aggregate Match 9 score in each rifle discipline: Service Rifle, NRA Match Rifle, AR Tactical (.223/5.56), AR Tactical (Open), FTR and F-Open, high Junior and high Woman.
- Awards will be given to the high aggregate Match 9 score per NRA Classification. Classes with 4 or less competitors will be combined with the next higher class.
- Competitors are limited to one award per Match.
