RULES

Current NRA High Power Rules (May 2020 Update) will apply including any provisional rules. Block times will be used for all stages. Empty Chamber Indicators are required and will be available for \$2.00 at the range. The challenge fee is \$3.00 upon initiating a challenge. The fee will be refunded if the challenge is resolved in favor of the challenger by the jury. SF&GA Rifle Range Rules will be followed. Shooters must have zeros for the 600-yard line. If the shooter cannot get a round on the target by 5 shots, the shooter will not be allowed to continue the match. This is referred to as the "5 Shot Rule" and will be

Ammo: Safe ammunition to be supplied by competitor, no larger than 35 caliber. Bullet weight must be 75 grain or heavier for shooting at 600-yard lines.

COMPLIANCE

The Match Director may check for proper weights, rifle and supporting equipment configuration at any time.

ELECTRONIC TARGETS

Matches will be fired on Electronic Targets. NRA Rule on Electronic Scoring Rule 10.17 will be used. There will be no pit duty, but all competitors will have scoring duty and limited assistance in mounting and storage of target frames will be required. During competitions only the relay shooting, their scorers and match officials will be allowed on the firing line. Please bring a tablet if you have one, we will have loaner tablets if you do not have one.

CLASSIFICATIONS NRA Classification system will be used. Unclassified shooters may use an assigned

classification or shoot in the Master Class. Four or more unclassified shooters may constitute a separate class. Classes that do not have 5 competitors will be combined upward.

AWARDS

Individual Match Awards: Awards will be given to the highest aggregate Match 9 score in each rifle discipline: Service Rifle, NRA Match Rifle, AR Tactical, FTR and F-Open, highest Junior and highest Woman.

Awards will be given to the highest aggregate Match 9 score per NRA Classification. Classes with 4 or less competitors will be combined with the next higher class. Competitors are limited to one Award per MATCH.

Team Match Awards: Team winners will be based on the 2-day aggregate score of each team. There will be awards for the top aggregate scoring team for each of the following rifle disciplines: Service Rifle, NRA Match Rifle, AR Tactical, FTR and F-Open.

TEAM MATCH

RULES

NRA rules shall govern this Team Match, specifically, Rule 8.3 Team Time Allowance, Rule 10.17 Electronic Scoring Targets, Rule 11.6.8 Squadding of Team, Rule 12: Team Officers Duties and Position, Rule 19.12: Team Classification shall be based on the average of the team member's individual classification.
