# **NEW ENGLAND ALL STAR SHOOT-OFF**


**Saturday, September 14, 2024 at 2PM**

On Saturday afternoon of the old Zone One Championship, Scarborough Fish & Game will host the **New England All Star Shoot-Off**. This is an invitational event featuring some of New England's top men and women shooters going head-to-head for winner-take-all cash prizes. But this isn't just for the top shooters, everyone present can get in on the fun in the calcutta.

Just prior to the Shoot-Off we will have a calcutta (auction), so you can bid on your favorite shooter (or shooters) and have your name partnered with them to win money. There will be a separate calcutta for the men and for the women.

- **Ten men and five women compete in separate 6 pair (12 target) shoot offs, to determine the top 3 men and top 2 women.**
- **PLUS...A Super Final. Top 3 men and top 2 women (from the first round of 12 targets) shoot an additional 5 pairs (10 targets) each, to determine the winning shooters (1 man and 1 woman will win!)**
- **The winning shooters (1 man and 1 woman) will win \$500 PLUS half of their respective calcutta pot**
- **The winning bidder will win the other half of the respective calcutta pot**

# **NEW ENGLAND ALL STAR SHOOT-OFF**

## **DETAILS for SHOOT-OFF and CALCUTTA**

### **SHOOT-OFF**

- The event will be on the field in front of the club house
- Starting positions will be drawn when the shooter registers in.
- Two separate events...men will be one event and women will be one event.
- Men will view single targets together, at their start. Women will all view single targets together, at their start.
- All ten men will shoot 6 pair for score, then the women will do the same.

**PLUS...A SUPER FINAL:** The top three scores (and ties) for men and top two scores (and ties) for women, will move to the super final.

- Super Final: After the women have shot, the top three men will return to shoot 5 additional pair, to determine the winner. Their scores will reset to zero. Starting positions will be a random draw. In case of tie(s), the men will shoot two pair in a sudden death style shoot off. After the men finish, the top two women will follow the same process for their super final.
- NSCA rules apply to malfunctions, no birds, etc.

### **CALCUTTA**

At 2 pm, on Saturday of the old Zone One Championship, we will start the calcutta (auction). As a spectator, you will have the opportunity to bid on your favorite shooter (or shooters) that you think will win the event. You can bid on as many as you want. (We expect shooters to be won with amounts between \$50 to \$200, but this can change based on the crowd's enthusiasm.)

- Each shooter's name will be presented, one at a time, to be bid on.
- As soon as you are called the winning bidder, you will immediately be asked to pay in cash or check only. If you have a check and wish to keep bidding, we can hold the check until the end.
- You must have cash or check to bid, if you don't have cash or check, the shooter will go to the next bidder.
- There will be two pots, one for the men and one for the women.
- Each pot will be split between the winning shooter and the winning bidder on that shooter.
