COMMEMORATIVE MATCH: D-Day Survival on the Beach

OPEN TO: All Safe Shooters.

DATE: June 14, 2025. Squadding starts at 8:00. Firing starts at 9:00. Prep period starts 3 minutes before firing time.

PLACE: Scarborough Fish & Game Assn., Inc., 21 Fish and Game Lane, Scarborough ME 04074. Located at the intersection of Two Rod Road & Holmes Road. Across from Beech Ridge Speedway.

ENTRIES: Limited to 60 competitors. Advance registrations accepted. Preference to Juniors, then NRA members. Minimum of 6 people.

FEES: Registration fee \$20.00. Make checks payable to Scarborough Fish & Game Association.

ADVANCE REGISTRATION:

RIFLE: Any rifle used during the landing on D-Day, June 6, 1944. Only rifles with iron sights may be used to count for competition. Fixed bayonets are optional. Participants can shoot more modern rifles but will not be counted in competition.

EQUIPMENT: Rifle, field gear (canteen, bayonet, ammo belt), shelter halves allowed. No match sights, stools, spotting scopes, shooting mats, jackets, gloves, slings, or other *match grade* gear. The intent here to use only “as issue” type rifles. Spotting scopes will be allowed for sighting rounds only. Binoculars and original slings are acceptable. Eye and ear protection recommended.

POSITIONS: Any (safe) position of the standard four positions: prone, offhand, sitting or kneeling.

OPEN BOLT INDICATOR: Will be required to be used. Available for \$2.00.

COURSE OF FIRE: 48 shots – HUMAN SILHOUETTE TARGET

Stage 1: Any position, 16 record, rapid fire, 100 yds, 2 minutes. No sighters.

Stage 2: Any position, 16 record, rapid fire, 200 yds, 3 minutes. No sighters.

Stage 3: Any position, 16 record, rapid fire, 300 yds, 4 minutes. No sighters.

MATCH: Aggregate of Stages 1 thru 3

CLASSIFICATION: ALL SHOOTERS WILL COMPETE IN ONE CLASS. AWARDS: Winner's name will be engraved on Club Trophy.

SCORING: Scoring at Match Directors option.
